

Prayer List for Front-line Healthcare Workers

Sunday: Pray for their families – safety and health, especially for protection from the virus. Pray that their families can care for them well and for love, peace, and encouragement to blanket their homes. Pray for their strength as many are going long stretches without seeing their family members in healthcare.

Monday: Pray for energy, endurance, and perseverance as healthcare workers serve an influx of patients during this time. Pray for them to stay focused and have wisdom as they interact with their patients, and for them to bring empathy and compassion to them.

Tuesday: Pray for the Lord's provision of PPE (personal protective equipment) like masks and gloves and for the Lord to protect frontline workers from the virus and other illnesses. Pray for God to bless them with adequate sleep to be able to recharge.

Wednesday: Pray for the Spirit to move and the gospel to go out among healthcare workers that many would be saved. Pray for them to seek God for strength, help, and salvation as they reach their own personal limits and to acknowledge their need for a Savior. Pray they would be moved to reach out to a Christian friend or Bible-believing church during this time.

Thursday: Pray for those frontline workers who are Christians and for opportunities to show and share Christ wherever they are. Pray for the fruit of the Spirit to be evident in them as they care for patients and interact with their colleagues.

Friday: Pray for the different hospitals in Chicago, major and minor. Some suggestions might be Stroger, Northwestern, Swedish Covenant, Rush, St. Joseph's, UIC, UofC, Illinois Masonic, Kindred, Lurie Children's, Loretto, Weiss, Loyola.

Saturday: Pray for all the urgent care clinics and doctors' offices that are being flooded with initial screenings of COVID-19.
