We will be spreading out a bit further, as well. Thanks so much for your flexibility amidst all these changes. If this year has done anything, it's gotten us used to change, right?

Other Important Recording Details:

Dress code: We will be wearing robes, but please be mindful of what you are wearing on your feet and legs. Since we will be more spread out, we will see what you are wearing on the bottom half. Please avoid tennis shoes and sweatpants. 😊

Materials: For this recording you will have your robe, a black folder, your music and a candle. When you arrive for rehearsal, you can pick up your black folder, candle and robe in the choir room and then find a seat in the Sanctuary. We will have designated locations for you to stand during the recording and we will direct you to those locations at the right time.

If your name is NOT on this list or is on the list and shouldn't be, please let me know. This will impact our standing arrangement, so we appreciate your double checking.
