Unexpected Feast (vs. 22–23, 36)

- Themes: blasphemy, consecration, light & worship

Unexpected Clarity (vs. 24–33)

- Jesus makes an unmistakable claim to deity.

Unexpected Nuance (vs. 34–39)

- Jesus claims, not equivalence, but equality.

Unexpected Mercy (vs. 37–42)

- Jesus patiently pursues hostile hearts.

Takeaways:

- Jesus didn't stutter.
- Jesus deserves our worship.
- Jesus welcomes you where you are.

- Ask someone what their 2020 highlight was.

Father, help me to speak words of truth to those around me this week.

- Invite someone over for a spiritual conversation.
- Give someone an encouraging list of Bible verses.


New Series: *Resurrection*
