REDEMPTION PROJECT UPDATE

This year our Redemption Project partnered with Living With Hope to address a critical physical and spiritual need by providing mobility devices to people with disabilities in Africa.

Since last Sunday, we've blown past our initial goal of \$78,000, which would fill a shipping container with 240 wheelchairs bound for Kenya. Through your incredible generosity, we've raised over \$100,000 to date! Thank you so much for your faithfulness in blessing these lives.

However, the need is still great. There are still over 2,000 kids on the waiting list for wheelchairs.
