Alissa Bauer Japan

Alissa serves with a church planting team in one of the largest unreached nations in the world: Japan. There are more than 39 million people in the Greater Tokyo area and 99.5% of them are without hope in Christ. Alissa and her team are focusing on Southwest Greater Tokyo to share about the surpassing worth of knowing Christ.

#### **Prayer requests**

- Pray for Alissa as she studies Japanese and for her to gain proficiency with this difficult language.
- Pray for unity for her team and that this would be a witness to the Japanese people. Pray for the Spirit to work among the Japanese and to draw more to Himself.
- Pray for her to persevere and to have joy as she adapts to a new culture.

#### **ACTIVE**



David ("Andy") & Ruth Anderson Spain

The Andersons serve with TEAM in Spain, teaching and discipling students at the Evangelical Christian Academy near Madrid. Andy teaches music, Bible, and Spanish, while Ruth teaches English and serves as a guidance counselor. Andy and Ruth have numerous opportunities daily to reach non-believing students along with caring for the many missionary kids attending ECA. They are involved in a local church and seek to reach their neighbors for Christ as well.

- The Andersons' school exists primarily to serve children of missionaries, but more and more Spaniards are attending because they are dissatisfied with the public schools. Pray that these students and their families will receive Christ as their Savior.
- Pray for the MKs (missionaries' kids) at ECA, that they will own their faith and have a vibrant walk with God. With the rocky spiritual soil of Spain, they see few lives transformed and can become hardened themselves.
- Pray for the Andersons' perseverance in sharing Christ with Spanish friends, and pray that Christ would make their neighbors hungry for something more so they would respond to the gospel.
- Pray that God will provide more teachers to fill the gaps.



Ed & Denise Aulie Mexico

Ed and Denise Aulie serve with Last Frontiers in Mexico doing evangelism and church planting among the Nahuatl and Ch'ol people. They travel into mountain villages where there is no gospel witness with the purpose of establishing churches. Serving as Bible teachers, encouragers, and mentors, the Aulies seek to disciple indigenous Christian leaders to catalyze missions in Mexico. Ed and Denise also facilitate Theological Education by Extension (TEE) in various towns, allowing ministry training to happen in the everyday contexts of people's lives without taking them away from family, work, and community.

- Pray for the believers in Tlaxcantitla who need God's help to build a place for worship.
- Pray for Martin, who showed great leadership potential but has fallen into sin.
- Pray for Lito and his wife Yazmin, who are evangelizing in villages with no established church.
- Pray for the right location to build a small cabin to best reach out to area villages.

Patty and Doug serve with International Students, Inc., at the University of Colorado, Colorado Springs. They are befriending, serving, and discipling international students from countries around the world. Patty's focus is campus outreach through ISI events and opportunities. Doug assists in these outreaches while also focusing on writing materials for use in outreach and discipling.

- Pray for God's leading in making contacts on campus and for the Spirit to speak through the Bastians as they interact with students.

Lee and Regina Bloch Brazil

The Blochs serve as church planters with Converge's Southern Cone Initiative to the least-reached municipalities of Southern Brazil. They are asking God for a gospel movement within their generation in each of these areas. Lee's dual passions for God's Word and people guide him as he teaches pastors and church leaders in Brazil and seeks to equip churches already present. Regina, a native of Brazil, is passionate about discipling women and starting and building children's ministries, which she has been doing since before she married Lee in 2008. Their goal is to plant churches in the least-reached areas of Southern Brazil and to help Brazilian churches multiply and develop Great Commission pathways into all the world. Lee and Regina want to see the gospel preached to the least reached—those who have never heard of Jesus.

- Pray for the Holy Spirit to prepare hearts to receive the gospel message, and for the gospel to spread and transform communities.
- Pray for their current initiatives: a growing women's discipleship ministry
  called Women of the Word, trainings for Brazilian pastors, and an
  afterschool kids' program to reach the community for the gospel.
- Pray for God's continued blessing in ministry; for strength, wisdom, and guidance for Lee and Regina; and for physical health and spiritual protection against the Enemy.

The Boulos family serves locally with i2 Ministries. They are passionate about reaching Muslims in the greater Chicagoland area and praying for persecuted Christians in Egypt, the Middle East, and North Africa. Raouf teaches classes to effectively train and equip Christians to evangelize Muslims; his part-time work as an Arabic interpreter for the Cook County court system allows him to regularly encounter Muslims and share his faith. Raouf is in touch with different Muslim contacts daily, and his goal is to build a core team to evangelize and disciple new believers who come out of Islam.

He also leads individual and group retreats. Sonja serves as a valuable resource for missionary children with learning disabilities, and serves alongside Mike in working with women.

She now teaches part-time in the Doctor of Missiology program, mentoring 22 students who are doing their doctoral research internationally.

The team has the privilege of sharing about Jesus with many Muslim-background refugees who have never before heard a clear presentation of the gospel—praise God that they regularly see some coming to faith in Christ!

Having previously served in Peru and Papua New Guinea, the Hudsons continue to serve with Wycliffe Bible Translators at JAARS in North Carolina. Dan works in Transportation and Maritime Services to train translators, missionaries, and nationals who are in ministry in a transportation safety and maintenance course. He also travels overseas when needed to conduct on-site training. Nancy's team checks newly-translated Scriptures before they go to print. She is a Scripture Prayer Coordinator for ICC, a training program for new missionaries, and leads a ladies' prayer time.

Currently there are 2,658 translations in progress, with an additional 2,163 languages still in need of translation. Of those 2,163, 1,879 are spoken languages and 284 are sign languages for the deaf. Cathy's activities include representing Wycliffe, resourcing recruits and inquirers with info/advice/encouragement, recruiting on campuses and at mission venues, contributing to Wycliffe sponsored events, and staying abreast of ever-changing personnel needs and opportunities.

- Pray for Cathy and her team members to work well together and discern how best to invest themselves.




