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FAMILIES IN NEED

CARIS PREGNANCY COUNSELING AND RESOURCES

Caris is a ministry committed to helping women and children thrive during and after unplanned pregnancy. They offer professional counseling, pregnancy testing, ultrasounds, support groups, and more to walk alongside the most vulnerable in our city. CARING FOR THE MOST VULNERABLE

139 DISABILITY MINISTRY OUTREACH

MINISTERING TO COOK COUNTY JAIL'S OFFICERS

Volunteer chaplains (men and women) are needed to support on-duty officers and civilian staff, who serve at the Cook County jail, at 27th & California Avenue. Volunteer chaplains work solo, serve one or more days each week, as many hours as they wish. This is not specifically evangelistic, but is a ministry of walking throughout buildings to visit on-duty staff, building relationships, asking how they are, listening to their concerns (and occasional joys), offering prayer, and sharing the Gospel where opportunities arise. Jail staff serve 24/7/365, so volunteer chaplains are needed every day and hour. There is an application process for this opportunity.
